

With help from our generous community of donors, the Tahoe Forest Health System Foundation was able to elevate patient care by purchasing and committing to fund the following lifesaving initiatives.



\$500,000 was designated from the TFHS Foundation's Area of Greatest Need by our Board of Directors to support the new 3T MRI project for Tahoe Forest Hospital's Diagnostic Imaging Department



The TFHS Foundation has funded over \$90,000 towards Oncology Support for cancer-specific support programs such as general support groups, Exercise for Energy, massage therapy, acupuncture, and much more. All programs concentrate on a whole-person approach to healing and come at no cost to the patient.



The **TFHS Foundation** received **\$306,338.84** in federal grant funding from HRSA for the enhancement of **Behavioral Health Services** for Tahoe Truckee community members. In addition to that **\$70,180.75** was raised for **Behavioral Health** outside of the HRSA grant.

#### Area of Greatest Need

When you designate your gift to Area of Greatest Need, the Foundation Board of Directors will direct your donation toward the Hospital's most significant need. In our undertaking to offer the best patient care experience possible, having access to comprehensive services and programs, as well as state-of-the-art technology and diagnostic equipment, is a vital necessity.

#### Gene Upshaw Memorial Tahoe Forest Cancer Center

The Gene Upshaw Memorial Tahoe Forest Cancer Center offers unmatched cancer care, equipment, and technology on par with most urban health care systems. They provide medical evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, PET/CT scans, ultrasound, digital mammography, chemotherapy infusion, and pharmacy/lab services. Additionally, physical therapy, family support programs, and psychosocial services are also offered. Gifts to the Cancer Center support further enhancement of services and the advancement of specialized equipment, both of which have a profound impact on the lives of our patients.

#### **Emergency Department**

The Tahoe Forest Health System Emergency Room is a full-service emergency department. Gifts to Emergency Services directly supports equipment and supply needs that assist with the functionality of the department. This crucial technology is more important than ever for our Level 3 Trauma Center.

#### Gifts of Cash

Gifts of cash, by check, or credit card are the most direct ways to give to TFHS Foundation. As a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization, your gift is tax deductible to the full extent allowed by law.

#### Gifts of Securities

After being held for a minimum of one year, stock that has increased in value is one of the most popular assets used for charitable giving. Donating appreciated securities is a simple gift that can offer a greater tax benefit than an equivalent in cash. Using appreciated securities entitles you to a charitable deduction for the fair market value of the donated asset, and you avoid paying the capital gains tax you would pay if you sold the appreciated securities.

#### Gifts From a Retirement Plan

If you are required to take a minimum distribution from a retirement account, a Qualified Charitable Distribution can be made from an IRA to the TFHS Foundation. This will allow you to lower your gross income and possibly reduce your income or estate tax by transferring the additional taxable income to TFHS Foundation.

#### . Gifts From a Donor Advised Fund

A Donor Advised Fund, or DAF, is like a charitable investment account. You are generally eligible to take an immediate tax deduction when you contribute assets from a DAF. You can recommend grants to TFHS Foundation from this type of tax-free investment fund.

#### · Gift From a Matching Gift Program

Double your donation to TFHS Foundation. Many employers sponsor matching gift programs that will match charitable contributions made by their employees. The match ratio is often 1:1, so by taking advantage of such a program, you can effectively double the impact of your gift.



### GIVING Tomorrow

If you are interested in supporting the long-term vision of the Health System, you can make a plan to give a gift to TFHS Foundation in the future so that we can continue to provide life-saving services for all community members. There are numerous estate planning techniques available that can maximize your testamentary charitable gifting and mitigate tax exposure. Please consult your tax advisor or estate planner for more information about tax deductions for charitable donations, and review a few of the options below:

#### Will or Trust Bequests

These gifts are made by including a provision in your will or trust document. TFHS Foundation receives your gift after your passing, at which time your estate can take the income and estate tax deductions.

#### Charitable Lead Trust

A charitable lead trust would pay TFHS Foundation for a certain number of years, after which the trust principal will pass back to you, your family members, or other heirs. It can be an excellent estate planning vehicle if you own assets that you expect will substantially appreciate in value. It can help you keep an asset in the family while enjoying some tax benefits.

#### · Charitable Remainder Trust

A charitable remainder trust is the mirror image of the charitable lead trust. Trust income is payable to you, your family members, or other heirs for a period of years, then the principal would come to TFHS Foundation. A charitable remainder trust can be beneficial because it provides you with a stream of current income.

Donors who notify the Foundation of their intent to include TFHS Foundation in their will or trust are instated as a *TFHSF Legacy Partner in Health* member. The Foundation would like to thank and recognize (based on donor preference) supporters for their intention to give while they are still living.
