1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:05 p.m.

Director Darzynkiewicz reviewed the Community Engagement Committee Charter.

2. ROLL CALL

Board Members Present: Director Darzynkiewicz, MD, Chair; Director Brown, Board Member

Staff in Attendance: Anna Roth, President & CEO; Louis Ward, COO; Brian Evans, MD, CMO (zoom); Kim McCarl, Chief Strategy Officer (zoom); Ted Owens, Executive Director Governance; Hillary Bayliss, Manager of Care Coordination; Karli Bunnell, Executive Director of Foundations; Jen Malone, Communication Manager; Alexis Luna, Engagement & Events Coordinator; Sarah Jackson, Clerk of the Board;

3. CLEAR THE AGENDA/ITEMS NOT ON THE POSTED AGENDA

No changes were made to the agenda.

4. INPUT – AUDIENCE

No public comment was received.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: November 12, 2025

Director Brown moved to approve the Board Community Engagement Committee minutes of 11/12/2025 as presented, seconded by Director Darzynkiewicz.

6. ITEMS FOR COMMITTEE DISCUSSION AND/OR RECOMMENDATION

6.1. CHIP Update/ Social Determinants of Health

The Community Engagement Committee will receive an update on the Community Health Improvement Plan along with SDOH.

- Lizzy Hennesey is unexpectedly absent today and unable to review the presentation.
- Committee reviewed the CHIP Task Force Roles and Responsibilities.
- Director Brown noted concern about the Goal of June 30th, 2026, and to get to the implementation in a timelier manner. She suggested the possibility of truncating the process to allow more time for implementation.
- CSO noted that the work of the CHIP is ongoing and overlaps over assessments.
- Discussion was held regarding overlapping engagement efforts and timelines from Community Health Needs Assessments and CHIPS.
- Manager of Care Coordination provided a verbal update on the Social Determinants of Health (SDOH) intakes across Outpatient departments.

 Denotes Action Item

- Within EPIC there are significant differences in the processes of the “health related social needs” assessments. There will need to be further assessments about how these intakes are taken. Further education across Departments needs to be communicated if this is a focus that the Health System would like to pursue.
- Inpatient has their process in place as this is a CMS guideline.

ACTION – At the next committee meeting agendize CHIP for a short (5 minutes) discussion on ways to potentially expedite the CHIP process.

ACTION – COO to bring Outpatient SDOH / Health Related Social Needs back in 6 months with an update to committee. Explore tools like Healthy Planet and Compass Rose for better tracking of social needs.

6.2. 5,000 Voices Update

The Community Engagement Committee will receive an update on 5,000 Voices

- CSO provided an update on the 5,000 Voices. Over 1500 survey responses have been received to date. “Community Sentiment”, “What’s Working”, and “Top Concerns” were reviewed.
- CEO provided feedback on demographic slide information.
- CMO agreed on commentary about “concierge” medicine.
- COO provided feedback on the positive response to the survey process and response rate and total.
- ED Gov questioned the Committee, prior to Covid and the Urgent Care clinics, the public was “trained” to utilize the system in a certain manner to access care. Do we need to “re-train” the public on how to access the system in a post-Covid system.

ACTION – CSO to present the next iteration of the 5,000 Voices update at the next Committee Meeting.

6.3. Environmental Stewardship Update

The Community Engagement Committee will receive an update on environmental stewardship.

- VP of Facilities provided a verbal update on the recently completed waste assessment conducted by Waste Free Tahoe. The complete report will be presented at the full Board of Directors meeting the following evening.
- He additionally provided a brief update on the expected report from Mazzetti regarding the Health System’s greenhouse gas emissions. That comprehensive report is expected by June.

ACTION – Add Environmental Stewardship update to the next Committee Meeting

6.4. Charter Review

The Community Engagement Committee will annually review and recommend approval of the committee charter to the full TFHD Board of Directors.

ACTION – Deferred to next committee meeting.

6.5. Sponsorship Update

The Community Engagement Committee will review the Sponsorship Committee activities.

- COO reviewed Sponsorship activities. It was noted that emphasis is placed on alignment with the Health System’s mission and maintaining budget constraints.
- Newly awarded sponsorships were reviewed.

- CEO reviewed Community Benefit activities surrounding recent community accidents and incidents.
- Significant discussion was held regarding surrounding community messaging and sponsorship messaging in regard to community incidents and accidents.

6.6 Navigation Center Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

- Director Brown provided an update on the TTHAC Ribbon Cutting.
- It is a well-designed and well thought out project.
- Meeting the staff from the Volunteers of America was incredibly impactful.

6.7 Small Wins

- The Community Engagement Committee thanked ED of Governance for his work at the TTHAC that earned him the GOAT at the previous committee meeting.
- The Committee then heard nominations for the current GOAT. It was unanimously decided that Brian Parrish, Director of Behavioral Health Services, for his tireless and incredible impactful work in his department following the recent tragic avalanche, should be awarded the GOAT.

7. REVIEW FOLLOW UP ITEMS / BOARD MEETING RECOMMENDATIONS / ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION

- There will be a multi-jurisdictional “State of” meeting hosted by the Town of Truckee with input from its organizations. The idea was generated from the multi-jurisdictional meeting, “Truckee Area Managers.” The exact date is yet to be determined.

The next meeting will be scheduled for early June.

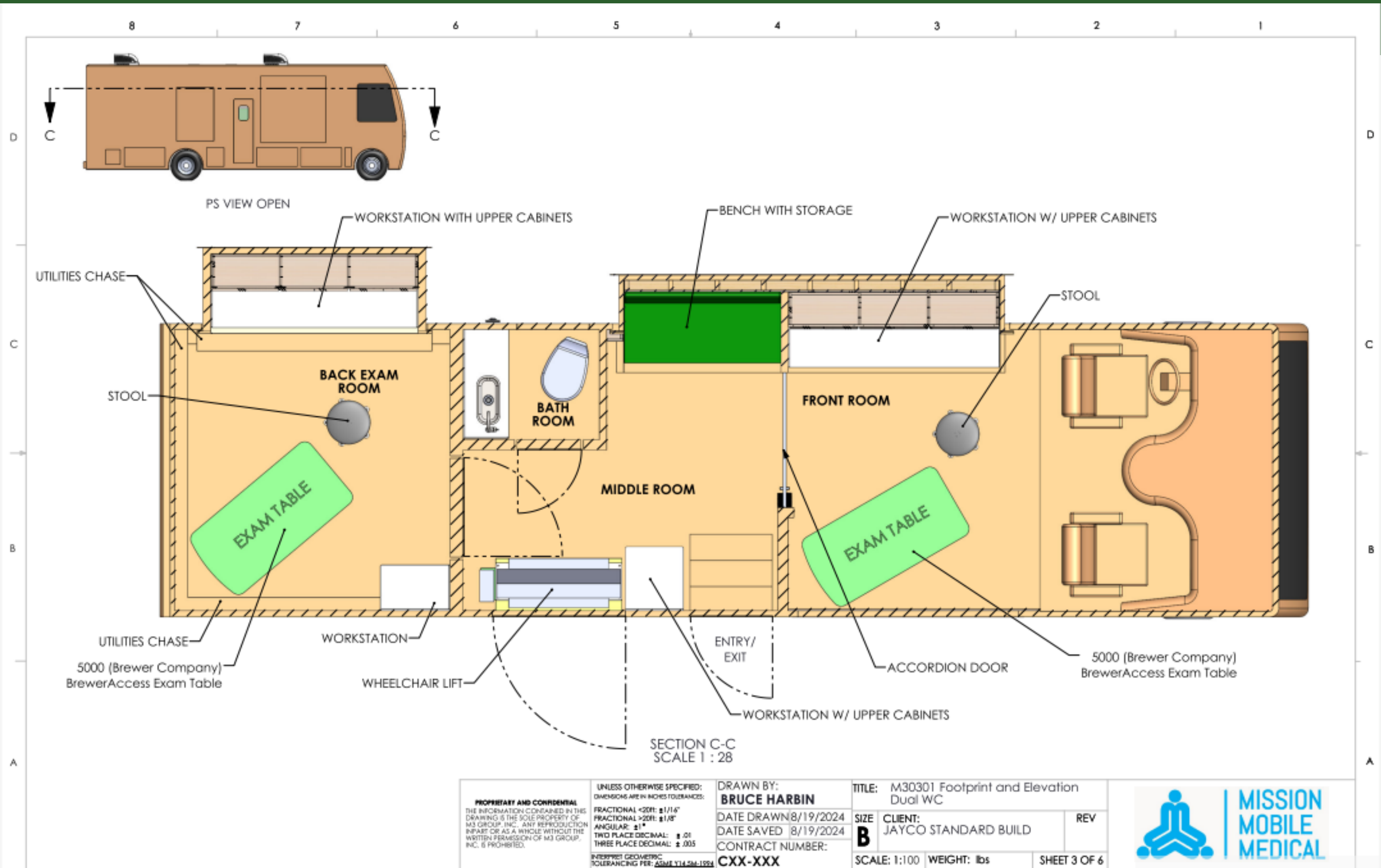

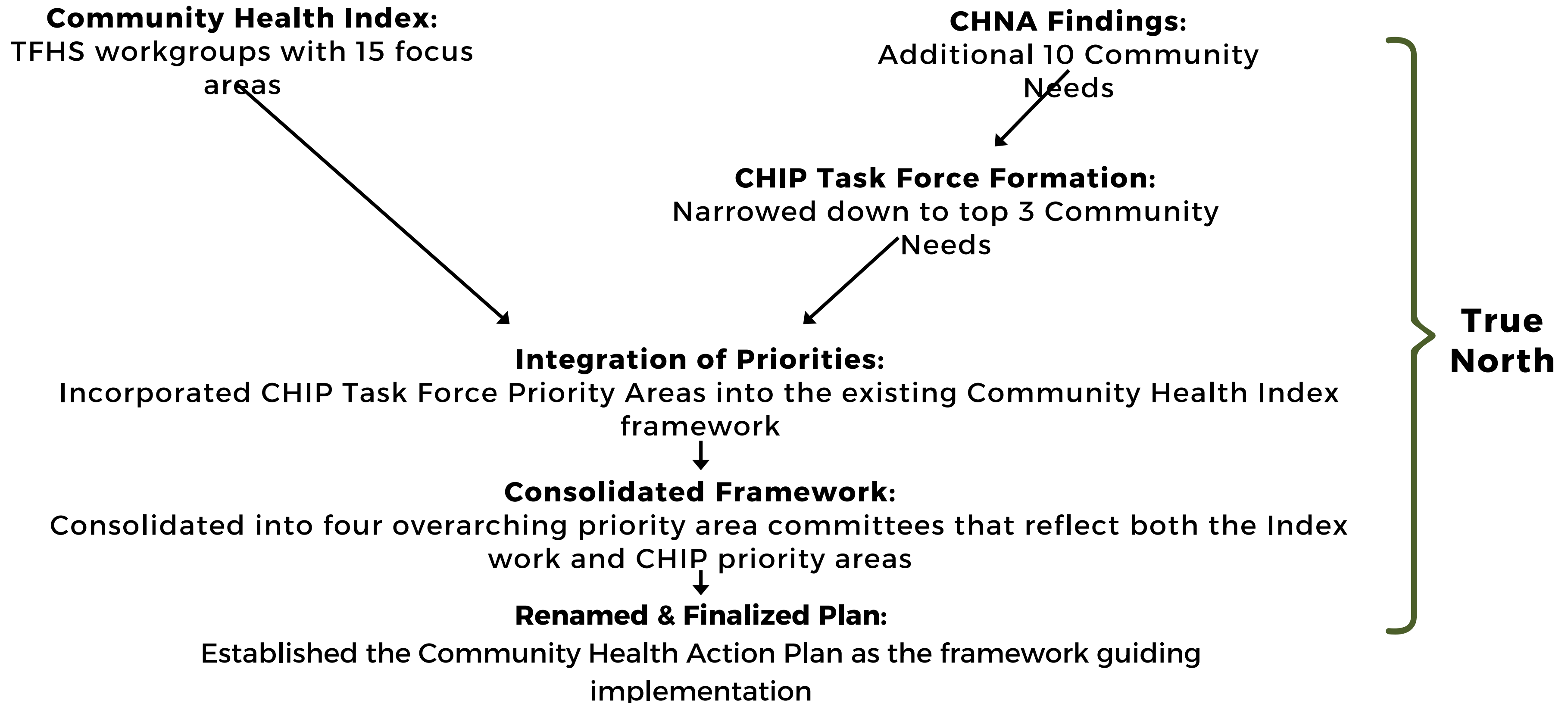
